DESCRIPTION:

The Deputy Returning Officer's (DRO) main responsibilities are to assist the Chief Returning officer in the administration of the YFS Elections.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- •Maintaining peace and order in the polling station
- Conducting the count of votes
- •Hiring and training of poll clerks
- •Assist and supervise in the opening and closing of poll stations
- •Assist in the approval of campaigning materials
- •Assist the CRO with All Candidates Meeting and All Candidates Debate
- •Assist the CRO in administrative tasks

QUALIFICATIONS:

- •Experience coordinating and administering student union elections with increased hours in February.
- •Ability to work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends.
- •Strong organizational skills
- •Strong leadership skills
- •Ability to work well alone and in groups
- •Previous experience in scheduling considered an asset
- Understanding of YFS elections procedures
- •Knowledge of York University Practices and Policies

DESCRIPTION:

The Poll Clerk assists the CRO and DRO in facilitating voting at polling stations.

RESPONSIBILTIES:

- •Ensure voters' are eligible to vote
- •Ensure voters' are handed the appropriate ballots and allowed to vote in secret without disruption.
- •Act impartially at all times
- •Facilitate voting at polling stations
- •Enforce YFS elections By-laws and rules
- •Set up, supervise and take down polling stations
- •Answer voters' questions, where appropriate, in a friendly and businesslike manner
- •Assist in the counting of ballots at the end of the Elections

QUALIFICATIONS:

- •Must be available to attend a one-hour paid training session
- •Must be Reliable and Punctual
- •Available to work Elections dates (Tuesday, February 13, 2023 at 8:00am to Friday, February 16, 2023 at 4:00pm) with a flexible schedule.
- •Ability to work entire mornings/afternoons or entire days uninterrupted is highly desirable and considered an asset.
- •Understanding of YFS elections procedures
- •Knowledge of York University Practices and Policies
